THE AMAZING HUNT PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

[UPDATED ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2026]

For purposes of this Policy and The Amazing Hunt Agreement, Release and Waiver, The Amazing Hunt event or activity being booked and participated in is referred to as the "Program."

- a. The Amazing Hunt accepts payment by direct deposit, cheque payable to Bill Lin, or credit card via PayPal. A PayPal invoice or payment link will be provided upon request. PayPal payments are subject to a 3% processing fee for Canadian dollar transactions and a 5% processing fee for payments made in other currencies. All quoted prices and payments are in Canadian dollars.
- b. Programs costing \$5,000 CAD or more and/or requiring third-party vendors, venues, products or services require a non-refundable Minimum Event Fee equal to 50% of the total Program cost plus all applicable third-party costs, payable at least three (3) weeks before the scheduled Program. Any outstanding balance must be received no later than 12 hours before the Program. Failure to pay by the applicable deadline may result in suspension or cancellation of the Program without liability. Any unpaid balance after the Program is subject to a \$20 CAD daily late payment fee.
- c. For Programs with a Minimum Event Fee of \$490 CAD or less, fewer participants may attend without refund, credit or price reduction. Additional participants will be charged \$100 CAD each, payable immediately by cash or PayPal; if unpaid, The Amazing Hunt may refuse to provide the Program to the entire group. For Programs with a Minimum Event Fee of more than \$490 CAD, participant changes are permitted up to 48 hours before the Program. After this deadline, the confirmed number of participants is final, with no refund, credit or price reduction for fewer participants. The Amazing Hunt may adjust the final invoice, per-person rate or applicable discounts to reflect attendance changes.
- d. For Programs with a Minimum Event Fee of \$490 CAD or less, the confirmed Program date is final once the Minimum Event Fee is received. For Programs with a Minimum Event Fee of more than \$490 CAD, date-change requests must be received at least seven (7) days before the Program and are subject to The Amazing Hunt's approval and availability. Any approved rescheduled Program must take place within the same calendar year. All Minimum Event Fees and other payments are non-refundable, except as required by applicable law.
- e. Where an organizer or representative makes a booking on behalf of a group, company or organization, The Amazing Hunt may rely in good faith on that person's authority to make the booking, approve payment and enter into this Agreement. Any dispute concerning such authority or payment authorization shall be resolved among the applicable parties and shall not require The Amazing Hunt to refund any Minimum Event Fee or other payment, or waive any applicable fees, except as required by applicable law.

- f. The Organizer must sign and return The Amazing Hunt Agreement, Release and Waiver by the deadline specified above. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the Program. Any Minimum Event Fee and other payments already received will remain non-refundable, except as required by applicable law.

THE AMAZING HUNT AGREEMENT, RELEASE, AND WAIVER

I, _____, as the organizer and, where applicable, authorized representative of _____ (the "Organizer"), arrange participation in the Program on behalf of the participating company, organization, or private group (the "Group") and acknowledge and agree to the following:

- 1. The Organizer accepts responsibility for organizing the Group's participation and for communicating all Program requirements, safety instructions, risks and conditions of participation to all attendees and ensuring that they comply with them. Where the Group is a company or organization, the Organizer confirms that they are authorized to enter into this Agreement on its behalf.
- 2. Attendees must be at least 19 years of age. If anyone under 19 participates, the Organizer confirms that all necessary consent from the participant's parent or legal guardian has been obtained. The Organizer will ensure that attendees complete any additional releases, waivers, authorizations or consents reasonably required by The Amazing Hunt.
- 3. Participation in the Program is voluntary. Each attendee is responsible for their own actions, personal safety, health, physical and mental condition, dietary restrictions and allergies. Attendees must not participate in, or must immediately stop, any activity they believe may cause illness or injury. The Organizer acknowledges that participation in, travel to or from, and activities associated with the Program may involve inherent and other risks, including injury, illness, disease, death, property damage or other loss, and accepts the risks associated with organizing the Group's participation.
- 4. Intending to be legally bound, the Organizer and, where applicable, the participating company or organization, to the fullest extent permitted by law, hereby waive, release and forever discharge The Amazing Hunt, the Program, its Producer, organizers, production crew, staff, contractors, affiliated organizations and legal entities, and all other persons associated with the Program, individually and collectively (the "Released Parties"), from any and all rights, claims, actions, causes of action, damages, liabilities, losses, costs and expenses, including legal fees, whether now existing or arising in the future, arising out of or relating to the Group's participation in, travel to or from, or activities associated with the Program.
- 5. The Organizer accepts responsibility for the organization and conduct of the Group and for ensuring that participants follow the Program's instructions and participation requirements. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Organizer and, where applicable, the participating company or organization agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from claims, liabilities, damages, losses, costs and expenses, including reasonable legal fees, arising out of or relating to the acts, omissions or participation of the Organizer or participants in the Program. The Organizer and, where applicable, the participating company or organization are responsible for determining and maintaining any insurance coverage considered necessary or appropriate for their participants.
- 6. The Amazing Hunt may take group photos and/or video during the Program for event recording and promotional purposes, including use on its website and social media. By signing the optional consent below, the Organizer consents to such recording and use to the extent the Organizer is authorized to provide such consent. If consent is not provided, The Amazing Hunt will not intentionally take promotional photos or videos of the Group.
